Nourish NOW Implements Montgomery County Multi-Cultural Food Stability Initiative in Partnership with The David and Mikel Blair Family Foundation

Rockville-based food recovery non-profit, Nourish NOW, has teamed up with local philanthropist David Blair and [The David and Mikel Blair Family Foundation](#), to deliver weekly emergency food assistance to thousands of area residents. In a sweeping initiative aimed at tackling hunger, The David and Mikel Blair Family Foundation has launched a partnership with Nourish NOW to deliver sustained weekly food assistance to Montgomery County communities hit hardest by the on-going public health crisis.

“Children, families, and seniors are starving,” said Brett Meyers, Executive Director of Nourish NOW. “That’s a fact and we need to do all that we can to provide them with a sustainable source of food assistance; David Blair has given us that opportunity and we look forward to working with the Blair Family Foundation to increase the impact of our multicultural food assistance programs.”

Nourish NOW and The David and Mikel Blair Family Foundation have tapped under-used resources across the county. The mobilization of area food truck operators and pairing their on-the-go capabilities with Nourish NOW’s Family Relief Boxes filled with a 3-day supply of non-perishable food, the charitable partnership has created a food strike team capable of delivering on-going weekly food security at the neighborhood level.

“Our communities, like others across the country, are feeling the physical and financial devastation of COVID-19,” said David Blair. “We are proud to partner with Nourish Now to provide food to the most vulnerable, and are inspired by the dedication of so many organizations and individuals who have come together to support those in need.
